

Author's Check List

Please tick the following 11 items before you submit the manuscript to JSIAM Letters. You should realize that your publication may be postponed if you don't or can't tick all items.

- I have carefully read "Guideline of JSIAM Letters", and then I have written my manuscript according to it.
- I have carefully read "Instructions for preparation of manuscript with jsiamletters.cls (JSIAML_instructions.pdf)", and then I have written my manuscript according to it.
- Each author has checked his/her name and affiliation.
- In title, section headers, authors, affiliations etc., I have capitalized the first letters of the first words and the unique nouns. I have used lowercase letters for common nouns, verbs, adverbs, etc., except they are the first words. But I have used capital letters when lowercase letters are unusual, for example, abbreviations (e.g. SOR), and the pronoun "I".
- I have written my manuscript without going over text-area (namely, without "overflow").
- I have obeyed the limit of the number of pages without adjusting the line spacing ($\text{\textbackslash}vspace$, $\text{\textbackslash}baselinestretch$, ...), the font-size ($\text{\textbackslash}small$, $\text{\textbackslash}scriptsize$, ...) and so on.
- I have spell-checked all texts in my manuscript using appropriate software.
- I have paid attention to visible size of all fonts embedded in the EPS and JPEG files, and I also have checked the license of all embedded fonts.
- I have built the EPS and JPEG files whose volumes are as small as I can.
- I have made sure of the references.
- I have drawn Table descriptions, which are representable by Latex commands, without image files.
